

Woodspring Priory

Visit to Woodspring Priory, near Weston – S – Mare

Thursday 10th January 2019 between 1.00pm and 5.00pm.

Woodspring Priory lies adjacent to the sea in a quiet valley to the north of W-S-M. Originally founded in 1210, it flourished in the 15th Century when the tower and the nave of the church were rebuilt. At Henry V111's dissolution, the buildings became a farmhouse, which was added to in 1701.

The property belongs to the Landmark Trust, which lets it out as holiday accommodation. James has hired it for a short period in January, and is making it available for **GayWest members only** to come and wander round the whole building and grounds between 1 and 5pm on the 10th of January.

There will be a charge for this of £4.00 per person to include a tea of Scone, Jam and Cream, plus cake. All of the money will go to GayWest funds.

If interested you will need to pay and sign-up in advance to facilitate catering arrangements.

See Jim about this, you will need to make your own way there, or share lifts, and you will need to park in the **FREE public car-park** close to the sea.

The car-park is found to the right as you approach the Priory,

Straight ahead is a narrow cul-de-sac with no parking upon pavements, you will be given full directions from the M5 to the Priory.
