<u>Vegan Paella</u> Feeds 4 ready in 45 minutes Ingredients

1 1/2 tbsp. of olive oil

300g closed cap mushrooms, sliced

1 1/2 tsp smoked paprika

1/2 tsp cayenne pepper

2 tsp cider vinegar

1/2 tbsp. soft brown sugar

1 onion thinly sliced

1 red pepper sliced into strips

900ml vegetable stock

300g paella rice

200g frozen garden peas

1 lemon cut into wedges.



Method

- 1 Heat 1 thsp. of the olive oil in a 28cm pan, tip in the mushrooms and cook for 10 mins; until golden. Add the paprika and cayenne, then cook for a further 2 mins before adding the cider vinegar. Once the liquid has been absorbed, add the brown sugar and cook for a further 2 mins. Spoon onto a plate and set aside.
- 2 Add the remaining olive oil to the pan, along with the onion and red pepper. Cook for 5 mins, until starting to soften, then stir in the mushrooms along with the vegetable stock.
- 3 Scatter in the rice and season. Bring to the boil, then reduce the heat and simmer for 15 minutes without stirring. The rice should be cooked, but still have some bite.
- 4 Remove the pan from the heat and sprinkle over the peas. Cover and leave to sit for 15 minutes. Stir in the peas, season, then serve with lemon wedges on the side. Eric

Six commuters coughing


Five golden friends
