ALEXANDER'S RAG TIME BAND

In 1938 Hollywood's 20th Century-Fox film studio produced a film which was Oscar-winning and featured a
host of stars popular at the time and still well-remembered today.

Music and lyrics were by Irving Berlin who wrote no less than 26 songs for this delightful film.

Top of the bill was **Alice Faye**, Tyrone Power, Don Ameche and Ethel Merman (all of whom are firm favorites of mine.)

The plot revolves around a struggling small band conductor (Power) and a young aspiring female singer (Faye); their paths cross in a night club and through a miss-understanding, the band leader gets hold of the song-sheet she (Faye) brought with her and starts playing it. Faye hears the music, takes to the stage and sings a wonderful rendition of "Alexander's Rag Time Band" which is greeted with much enthusiasm by the otherwise bored audience.

The night club owner says he likes their music and will hire them but only as a group.

This leads to even more antagonism between the two principal characters: and the lady is particularly outraged!

In between their problems, along comes ETHEL MERMAN who looks

divine and warbles equally divine songs that Berlin ever penned. The conductor and his musicians get their call-up papers, the band dissolves, and they go off to war. During the conflict, the musicians form another band and entertain the troops at moral-boosting concerts, and when the war is over they go back home and the band is reformed in civvy-street.

For Faye, her career has nose-dived and she is singing at the lowest and most devasting time of her career.

Then again, by some cinematic stroke of luck, the band leaders hears of her shows and visits the downtown sleazy venue where Faye is earning a pittance and has slipped into a deep mood of depression and anxiety. On hearing her sing, Power approaches her and wins her confidence and she agrees to sing with the band again "for old times sake". Of course it is a huge hit and highly successful

and Faye renews her singing activities with the band. Better still

their romance is re-kindled and glory be! There is one of the happiest endings of all films.

I never tire of watching this film and have at least two copies on DVD,

In later years, I had the greatest of pleasure and honour of meeting Alice Faye who was on a visit to London: she agreed to appear at a bijou cinema in May (of which I was a member) and so the chance of a lifetime came when my name was called and I met this lovely screen apparition in person!

It was and remains for me, an unforgettable occasion.
